

## **Electronic Prescriptions**

An electronic prescription is a computer generated prescription sent electronically from your health care provider directly to our pharmacy. Electronic prescriptions are sent using a private, secure and closed network. Electronic prescriptions usually travel immediately to our pharmacy with no need to drop off a paper prescription. The electronic prescription process adds increased patient safety by preventing medication errors. Our pharmacy now accepts electronic prescriptions for controlled substances in addition to most other medications.
